## ART SCHOLARSHIPS

### WHAT QUALITIES ARE BEING ASSESSED?

Candidates for the Sixth Form Art Scholarship should currently be studying GCSE Art. The successful candidate would be expected to study a full A Level Art course.

You should be committed to Art and able to demonstrate ability, passion and a love for the subject beyond conventional expectations. You should also be able to demonstrate an eagerness to get involved with extra-curricular activities such as art clubs, talks, and workshops.

Drawing and perceptual ability should be of a high standard and you should be able to provide evidence of an aptitude for the creative and experimental. You should also be able to provide evidence of recent visits to exhibitions.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON THE ASSESSMENT DAY?

DIGITAL PORTFOLIO – to be submitted in advance

The deadline for submission of your digital portfolio to the admissions teams will be confirmed at a later date. Your portfolio should contain work which is relevant to GCSE Art and any other personal work you may have produced, including:

- Evidence of artist research in sketchbook presentations - relevant to your GCSE Art projects.
- Evidence and ability to discuss exhibitions you have attended (including virtual exhibitions) and visual research relating to a particular artist's work.
- Evidence of experimentation with different processes and techniques - creative use of media
- Evidence of drawing and recording - skilled observational drawings and photography
- One or two final pieces you have produced of which you are most proud (this can include e.g. photography, sculpture, print or painting...)

### INTERVIEW

Your interview will involve discussion around your digital portfolio and your passion for the subject, including any exhibitions you have attended (including virtual exhibitions) and the artists that inspire you. The panel will include members of the Visual Arts department.

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# SIXTH FORM SCHOLARSHIPS

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## DESIGN SCHOLARSHIPS: PRODUCT DESIGN

### WHAT QUALITIES ARE BEING ASSESSED?

Candidates for the Sixth Form Design Scholarship should currently be studying GCSE Design Technology - Resistant Materials or Textiles. The successful candidate is expected to study A Level Design Technology.

You should be committed to Design Technology and demonstrate a high level of design and making skills. You should demonstrate competent use of ICT skills through SolidWorks and 2D Design where appropriate in the design and realisation of functional or aesthetic products. You should also be able to show evidence of commitment and achievements to date in Design Technology either at school or in external clubs or societies. This may also include involvement in school clubs or an Arkwright Scholarship application.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON THE ASSESSMENT DAY?

#### INTERVIEW

Applicants are required to attend an interview with members of the Design Technology department and bring with them a structured Design portfolio containing:

1. Evidence of the design, development and planning of an appropriate product (max. 4 x A3 pages).
2. Photographic evidence of hand and or CAD/CAM manufacturing skills in the design and realisation of a functional product or aesthetic model. One of these products/models should be made independently of lessons and include a short evaluation and photographic evidence to highlight progression during its design and manufacture. Where possible, the product/model may be submitted for evaluation as part of the scholarship interview (max. size 1 x A3).
3. A written personal statement containing details of design or technological-based events, co-curricular activities, involvement in clubs or societies or projects in which the candidate has been involved at school, home or elsewhere may be submitted (min. 300 words).

## DESIGN SCHOLARSHIPS: TEXTILES

### WHAT QUALITIES ARE BEING ASSESSED?

Candidates for the Sixth Form Design Scholarship should currently be studying GCSE Design Technology - Resistant Materials or Textiles. The successful candidate is expected to study A Level Fashion and Textiles.

You should be able to demonstrate a clear passion and interest in Textiles through your work and other means outside of school. You should also be able to communicate your understanding of the subject in the broader sense and have some awareness of the issues surrounding the Textiles and Fashion industry today. Creativity and the willingness to experiment without fear of failure are qualities that will be valued.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON THE ASSESSMENT DAY?

#### INTERVIEW

Applicants are required to attend an interview with members of the Design Technology department and bring with them a structured Design portfolio containing:

1. A selection of your work completed at GCSE to discuss your thought process. Please include evidence of manufacture.
2. A written personal statement demonstrating further interest in the subject and why the scholarship would be important to you.
3. If you have produced any work outside of class you are more than welcome to show that as well.

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## **DRAMA SCHOLARSHIPS**

### **WHAT QUALITIES ARE BEING ASSESSED?**

GCSE Drama would be helpful, but a candidate may demonstrate equal knowledge and experience through participation in extracurricular Drama. The successful candidate may want to complement their involvement in school Drama by taking A Level Theatre Studies but this not a requirement of the Scholarship.

You should be able to provide evidence of commitment to the subject, as shown by your interest in and support of school Drama, your potential at A Level (where relevant), and examples of your achievements in school productions or achievements in Drama outside school. If you are taking GCSE Drama, you should also be able to give examples of achievements shown in lessons, workshops and written coursework potential at A Level (where relevant).

### **WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON THE ASSESSMENT DAY?**

#### **AUDITION**

You will prepare and perform a short audition piece in the form of a monologue taken from a full-length play of your choice. The monologue should last approximately 1-2 minutes and you will be expected to have read the whole text before your audition, so that you can discuss this during your interview.

#### **INTERVIEW**

The final part of your Drama Scholarship assessment will be an interview with members of the Drama department.

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## MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

### WHAT QUALITIES ARE BEING ASSESSED?

You must have the ability to perform to a high standard (a minimum of grade 8) and to demonstrate understanding of the music you perform, both through your playing and your ability to discuss the music using appropriate technical terms.

Successful scholars will also be expected to take a full and prominent part in all musical activities, including active participation in school orchestras and choirs.

We also expect our scholars to display a high level of musical leadership, helping the music department run musical ensembles.

Scholars may want to complement their practical activities by studying Music to A Level, but this is not a requirement of the scholarship.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON THE ASSESSMENT DAY?

#### RECITAL AND INTERVIEW

You will be asked to give a recital lasting between 10-12 minutes, with the repertoire being entirely of your choosing. You will then be invited to discuss your repertoire in appropriate technical terms, including matters of structure, origins and background and style/performance practice.

All candidates will be asked to sight-sing and complete aural tests at approximately grade 7 standard. Please state at the time of application what the audition piece/pieces will be and on which instrument(s). If you require a School accompanist, please indicate this on the application form.

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## SPORT SCHOLARSHIPS

### WHAT QUALITIES ARE BEING ASSESSED?

You should:

- be able to demonstrate outstanding sports skills in a chosen sport/s equivalent to county standard;
- be committed to a school team/s and be a positive influence within your team/s;
- assist with the coaching of a younger team;
- show a positive attitude to maintaining personal fitness and skill development in your sport;
- be a positive role model to others and be able to communicate openly with peers, younger athletes and the PE staff;
- be prepared to help with the organisation of some school sports events and fixtures.

Your application should be accompanied by:

- letters/support documentation from your present coach detailing your level of ability, potential and commitment;
- visual evidence (e.g. video) demonstrating, for example, ball skills or, in the case of gymnastics, a routine;
- presentation of your sporting achievements.

### WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON THE ASSESSMENT DAY?

#### PRESENTATION

You should create a 10-minute presentation outlining your personal sporting achievements, aspirations and goals. Within this you should answer the following questions:

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1. Why would you make a good sports scholar?
2. How do you see your role and involvement in school sport in the Sixth Form?
3. What new ideas could you bring to the PE Department?

You will deliver your presentation to an interview panel, which will include the Director of Sport. This will be followed by questions relating to your presentation.
